Sodan Hotline.

A confidential reporting system “Sodan* Hotline” is available to any person to raise genuine concerns about actual or suspected improper conduct or unacceptable behaviour at INPEX without fear of reprisal. Reports can be made anonymously.

Sodan reports can be made about any of the following:

- Activities that pose serious harm to health, safety and environment
- Theft, fraud or misappropriation
- Conduct or practices that breach a law or an INPEX Standard
- Negative impacts on the way INPEX operates
- Significant mismanagement or waste of funds or resources
- Workplace bullying, harassment, including sexual harassment, or discrimination
- Human rights violations including modern slavery or exploitation suspected to be occurring at INPEX or within its supply chains
- Action taken against, or disadvantage or detriment suffered by complainants as a result of using the Sodan Hotline.

The Sodan Hotline is also authorised by INPEX to receive a protected Whistleblower Report. Please refer to the INPEX Whistleblower Standard for more information.
